Delta Health Alliance is the new owner of the Leland Medical Clinic and will operate the clinic as a "patient-centered medical home" for area patients. For the last three years, DHA has assisted clinics in adopting this approach, which has been demonstrated to improve health outcomes of patients. The Leland Medical Clinic, a certified rural health clinic, is the first to be owned and fully operated by Delta Health Alliance. Under the direction of the new clinic director Jane Calhoun, clinical staffing will consist of new and familiar faces: Dr. Bobby Dale, DHA Chief Medical Officer, will have regular office hours at the clinic twice a month while Rhonda Potter, the clinic's new nurse practitioner, will see patients on a full-time basis. Former employees, Debra Clark and Flora Byrd, will remain on staff as the Office Manager and Clinic Nurse, respectively. Also, added to the clinic team will be Lula Reece, Clinical Assistant/Community Health Worker, Nastarcia (Star) Allen, Medical Assistant, and Jameshya Ballard, Registered Dietician. Dr. Ned Kronfol will remain as collaborating physician to the nurse practitioner.
